Pigpen Cipher



Pig Pen is a secret code or cipher that uses shapes to stand for letters. The code can be based on the placement of the letters into the grid system. For our purposes we will use the variation that is found in the Wolf Handbook under the Code of the Wolf adventure.

In this variation the letter “A” would look like “┐”. The letter “M” would look like “┌┐”. And the letter “Z” would look like “Λ”.

The message “HELLO WORLD” would read “┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐┐”.
